- Recognising all children participating in cricket (regardless of age, gender, race, religion, sexual orientation, ability or disability) have the right to be safe and protected from harm.
- Ensuring all individuals working at or for our club, such as officials, members, volunteers, managers, coaches and so on, have a responsibility for the safety of children.
- Providing an environment where the views of children, parents and volunteers are sought and welcomed on a range of issues. This will help us create an environment where people have the opportunity to voice any concerns.
- Ensuring all suspicions, concerns and allegations are taken seriously and dealt with swiftly and appropriately as per the policies and codes adopted by the club.
